## **RESEARCH AND STRATEGY DELIVERY**

## Research/Strategy Development Programme for 2012/13

#### **SUMMARY**

This Report provides the Partnership Board with an update on progress on delivering the Research and Strategy Development programme and seeks approval of amendments to the programme to reflect commitments made and changing priorities and funding opportunities identified since approval of the 2012/13 Business Plan at the Partnership meeting on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2012.

#### **DETAIL**

The Partnership at its meeting of 13 April 2012 agreed the HITRANS Business Plan for 2012/13 which includes a programme for Research and Strategy Development for 2012/13 in support of development, implementation and delivery of the HITRANS Regional Transport Strategy.

Work progressed throughout 2012/13 on delivery of the Programme as indicated in the Appendix to the report. This table represents the near final delivered position on the Research, Development and Delivery Programme.

The Programme has been amended in the period since the last Partnership meeting to reflect a number of new opportunities and a reduction in budget requirement for a number of projects. The changes are summarised below and more information is provided on each change in Appendix A to this report.

Summary of key Programme changes:

- Budget reduced for research on Timber transport research in line with cost of delivering the Upsticks study.
- Increase spend on Real Time Information project delivery.
- Modest increase in cost allocation to the Skye Air Service Feasibility Study to cover costs
  of Presenting the work and including additional Environmental analysis.
- Modest reduction in budget for Active Travel Infrastructure Delivery.
- Reduce budget for Regional Air Service Study with allowance made to complete this work in 2013/14.
- Reduce budget for Oban rail service enhancement work as this has been delivered at a lower cost than originally budgeted.

This programme includes provision for a modest overspend of £22,305 on our budget of £326,408.
