Scotland and Cycling



Increasing demand



- Since 2006, demand for rail travel has increased by over 30% with around 96 million ScotRail passenger journeys last year.
- Cycle Tourism, "bike packing", leisure cycling all being actively promoted and numbers of participants increasing.
- Scotland's Great Trails, NW500, Etape-Caledonian, Loch Ness, Pedal for Scotland all showing growth in cyclists.
