RESEARCH AND STRATEGY DELIVERY

Research/Strategy Development Programme for 2018/19

SUMMARY

This Report provides the Partnership Board with an update on progress on delivering the Research and Strategy Development programme and seeks approval of amendments to the programme to reflect commitments made and changing priorities and funding opportunities identified since approval of the 2018/19 Business Plan at the Partnership meeting on 20th April 2018.

DETAIL

The Partnership at its meeting of 20th April agreed the HITRANS Business Plan for 2018/19 which includes a programme for Research and Strategy Development for 2018/19 in support of development, implementation and delivery of the HITRANS Regional Transport Strategy.

Work is progressing on delivery of the Programme as indicated in the Appendix to the report.

The Programme has been amended to reflect changes that have been identified to the circumstances surrounding some projects. The changes are summarised below and more information is provided on each change in Appendix A to this report.

Summary of key Programme changes:

 Additional Active Travel budget allocation was secured from Transport Scotland following their invitation for RTPs to submit proposals to utilise some unallocated national budget before the financial year end. The award secured by HITRANS amounts to an additional £280,000 with no match funding requirement.
