# SHARED SERVICES UPDATE PUBLIC TRANSPORT INFORMATION PROVISON

#### **Purpose of Report**

To provide Members with an update on the shared service model for co-ordinating the provision of public transport information across the HITRANS area.

#### **Background**

Since 2014, HITRANS in partnership with Local Authority colleagues have developed a shared service approach in respect of public transport information. A Public Transport Information Officer was appointed in 2015 with the responsibility for co-ordinating the provision of public transport information across the HITRANS area and in so doing improve both the quantity and quality of public transport information available to the public.

The public transport information database has changed twice since 2015 with all five local authorities now using the DIVA system supplied by MENTZ (who provide the database for Transport for London). This contract was awarded in July 2020. Downstream data is provided to both Traveline Scotland and real time suppliers from the database including Vix who also manage all the real-time display assets across the HITRANS area. The database also produces automated static at stop information throughout the HITRANS area. In 2020/2021 this information is also now being used for other software providers such as Ticketer back office and various apps including the HITRANS GO-HI MaaS platform.

The list below outlines the volume of stops for which wayside information is currently produced by area:

- Highland Council 850 stops
- Moray Council 800 stops
- Orkney isles Council 50 stops
- Argyll & Bute Council 340 stops
- Western isles Council All Barra & Uist stops with roll out to other areas once data integrity is confirmed. Approx. 200 have been printed.

Work to improve the source information received from operators is being done in collaboration with the operators themselves and each local authority. This improvement is on an ongoing basis to ensure the output information received by the public is continually improving.

#### **Status Update**

The MENTZ system (DIVA) is being delivered to HITRANS by one of Mentz's existing clients National Public Transport Information (NPTI) on a subnet basis of their system which has allowed HITRANS to continue to provide a database within the current budget.

HITRANS officers have applied and secured funding for Smarter Choices Smart Places (SCSP) funding which will secure the continuation of the database provision and also allowed for the roll out of previously redundant real time signs in the Moray Council area. It has also enabled HITRANS to benefit from the time of a temporary officer post (at student grade) to help input data for the Western Isles onto the system for the first time and enable some of the operators in the Western Isles to provide real-time information and the purchase of new battery powered real-time displays in Stornoway, Tarbert, Lochmaddy and Balivanich.

Development work on at stop templates has been completed and tested and development work is ongoing to improve this provision. Timetables have been processed and printed for Highland and some areas of the Western Isles over the last 3 months. As a result of Covid, the production of displays was reduced or removed but we are now in the process of rolling out timetables for each area as service changes are introduced.

Training to all Local Authorities on an overview of DIVA and detailed stop management was completed in February 2021 with some individual breakout sessions arranged where required. It is important for local authority staff to have the opportunity to use the system on a regular basis to remain familiar with its functionality. Crib sheets have also been circulated to aid staff when using the system, in addition to HITRANS staff and our Account Manager at NTPI being on hand to help when needed.

Real time information throughout the HITRANS area has been further enhanced with the implementation of the new RTPI contract and infrastructure upgrades and configurations are now complete. A list of the 163 real-time assets across the HITRANS area is included within Appendix A.

One specific enhancement in respect of real time data is where VIX can obtain electronic data can be obtained directly from the operator as this enables a timelier display of real time information on street which has been particularly helpful with the regular changes resulting from the impacts of Covid.

Shiel Buses in Lochaber now have access to DIVA as part of the small operator module provision. This will allow them to update their own data and in time submit bus registrations via EBSR. Training will be carried out in November in 2021 by NPTI on a remote basis. LA's will be invited on a one staff member basis from each LA, to attend on a refresher training basis should they wish to do so.

Data migration as a whole has been challenging over the last year for all involved. We would like to thank all our Local Authority colleagues for their work to keep us updated. A shared folder will soon be set up using Dropbox where each LA will submit all manual registrations to their allocated folder.

### **Staffing**

Our current Public Transport Information Officer will be joining The Highland Council on a secondment starting on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and initially until March 2023. In order to ensure continuity for the shared service in their absence, the current postholder is training our intern on the DIVA system.

In order to provide a longer term solution, we propose to recruit a Project Support Assistant who would have primary responsibility for the maintenance of the public transport information database and the supply of information to all those systems which rely on this information. We also propose to retain an Intern within the team for at least 9 months per annum with a significant proportion of their time being allocated to help support this function. This will afford the opportunity to have more than a single FTE available for peak periods in information production. Officers will ensure that this provision will be undertaken within the current staffing allowance for this service.
