Purpose of Report

To update Members on the study investigating the provision of an overnight rail service from Caithness/Orkney to Central Scotland.

Midnight Train to Georgemas- aims

The aims of the study were to:

- Investigate current passenger and freight markets and connectivity from
- · Orkney/Caithness to Central Belt;
- Investigate train pathing to permit the sleeper to operate, including access to Central Belt for passenger and freight;
- Review possible rolling stock and traction options;
- Appraise freight opportunities;
- Review of mixed train operations; and
- Provide indicative costings for the service.

The study

Consultants Systra were appointed to carry out this piece of work. Timetabling, train planning, demand forecasting and stakeholder interviews have been conducted. A draft final report will soon be available.
