RESEARCH AND STRATEGY DELIVERY

Research/Strategy Development Programme for 2018/19

SUMMARY

This Report provides the Partnership Board with an update on progress on delivering the Research and Strategy Development programme and seeks approval of amendments to the programme to reflect commitments made and changing priorities and funding opportunities identified since approval of the 2018/19 Business Plan at the Partnership meeting on 20th April 2018.

DETAIL

The Partnership at its meeting of 20th April agreed the HITRANS Business Plan for 2018/19 which includes a programme for Research and Strategy Development for 2018/19 in support of development, implementation and delivery of the HITRANS Regional Transport Strategy.

Work is progressing on delivery of the Programme as indicated in the Appendix to the report.

The Programme has been amended to reflect changes that have been identified to the circumstances surrounding some projects. The changes are summarised below and more information is provided on each change in Appendix A to this report.

Summary of key Programme changes:

- Introduce a new item with a budget of £40,000 following the approval by the North Sea Region Programme of the MOVE project. This has required the reallocation of £20,000 from the ERDF Bid Project Support budget line and reflects the 50% intervention rate of the programme ensuring drawdown of match funding.
- Reduce the ERDF / INTERREG / SG Bid Project Support budget line to reflect the reallocation detailed for the MOVE project above to £20,000.
- Increase Rail Policy Development budget by £50,000 to £80,000 to reflect the award of Local Rail Development fund support for Fastline Faslane.
- Reduce Inverness Airport (Dalcross) budget to £30,000.
- £8,000 contribution to Knowledge Transfer Partnership project identified within ITS, Real Time and EV Strategy budget to reflect range of project focus.

With external funding from EU and Scottish Government in place and added to the Research and Strategy Delivery programme budget identified in the core programme there is currently sufficient funding in lace to meet a £1,030,000 programe. This is made up of £350,000 of core budget and a draw down against funds secured from SPARA 2020, INCLUSION, MOVE, Local Rail Development Fund, Sustrans Partnership programme, Knowledge Transfer Partnership and ERDF Smart Mobility.

Funding applications have been made to Energy Savings Trust e-Bike Grant Fund, Smarter Choices Smarter Places Open Fund, North Sea Region Smarter Combined Project, North Sea Region MAGS project, North Sea Region SUV Project, North West region FAME project and a SEUPB (Cross Border Cooperation Programme) application is in preparation. These additional project provide the opportunity for further radditionality to be achieved form our budget.
